### Financial Aid Priority Filing Date—December 1

If you haven't yet applied, you should do so quickly. Submit your Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at [studentaid.gov](https://studentaid.gov) or New Jersey Alternative Financial Aid Application (NJAFSA) at [hesaa.org](https://hesaa.org). Rutgers' federal school code is **002629**.

## February

- **Activate your NetID** *early February*
  - Activate your NetID at [netid.rutgers.edu](https://netid.rutgers.edu) to gain access to the myRutgers dashboard ([my.rutgers.edu](https://my.rutgers.edu)), where you can view important information about next steps.
- **Sign up for on-campus housing and/or dining** *mid-February–June*
  - Access the forms at [my.rutgers.edu](https://my.rutgers.edu) after you have enrolled and activated your NetID.

## March

- **Complete placement tests** *starting March 1 (within 30 days of enrollment)*
  - Placement testing for math, English, and most world languages is conducted online. Activate your NetID and access the tests at [my.rutgers.edu](https://my.rutgers.edu) under *Required for Enrollment*. If you enroll prior to March 1, you should complete all tests by March 30; otherwise, please complete tests within 30 days of enrolling. Students awaiting accommodations are not subject to these timelines.
- **Receive financial aid offer letter** *early March*
  - Financial aid offer letters will be available at [my.rutgers.edu](https://my.rutgers.edu) starting early March for all admitted students who submitted a FAFSA or NJAFSA by December 1. All admitted students who applied for financial aid after December 1 will receive their offer letter within two weeks of their offer of admission, but no earlier than early March.
- **Look for scholarship notification** *early March*
  - Scholarship recipients will receive information regarding their scholarship in their financial aid offer letter, which can be accessed at [my.rutgers.edu](https://my.rutgers.edu). Visit [admissions.rutgers.edu/scholarships](https://admissions.rutgers.edu/scholarships) for more information.
- **Choose a tuition payment plan (optional)** *March–June*
  - Rutgers offers several tuition payment plans that allow you to pay your term bill charges over time in convenient monthly installments. For more information, visit [go.rutgers.edu/paymentplan](https://go.rutgers.edu/paymentplan).

## April

- **Enroll in Two-Step Login with Duo** *early April*
  - The university requires all students to use a two-step login with Duo to access most services and tools requiring a NetID login, including the myRutgers dashboard. To learn more and enroll, follow the steps at [twostep.rutgers.edu](https://twostep.rutgers.edu).
- **Attend Admitted Student Open House** *April 9*
  - Save the date for Admitted Student Open House on Saturday, April 9. Check your email for Open House details and registration information.
- **Complete academic planning and advising** *April–August*
  - Learn about degree requirements and plan your fall course schedule. You are more likely to graduate on time by registering for at least 15 credits per semester. Find more information at [my.rutgers.edu](https://my.rutgers.edu).

## May

- **Accept our offer of admission** *by May 1*
  - Accept our offer of admission at [admissions.rutgers.edu/accept](https://admissions.rutgers.edu/accept). After May 1, we cannot guarantee your space will remain available. Students admitted after April 24 have one week to accept our offer of admission.

## June

- **Register for New Student Orientation** *by June 1*
  - Meet other new students, become familiar with campus, and have your questions answered. Visit [nso.rutgers.edu](https://nso.rutgers.edu) to learn more.
- **Submit your immunization record** *by June 1*
  - All incoming students are required to comply with NJ State and University immunization requirements. The requirements and reporting processes are found on the Rutgers Immunization Portal at [admissions.rutgers.edu/immunization](https://admissions.rutgers.edu/immunization). ## July

- **Submit your final official transcript(s)** *by July 1*
  - Your final records must include certification of any diplomas or degrees, as well as final grades for courses in progress at the time of your admission. Mail to: Undergraduate Admissions Operations Center, Proctor Hall, 65 Davidson Road, Suite 301, Piscataway, NJ 08854.
- **View your term bill** *mid-July*
  - Term bills are available at [finance.rutgers.edu/student-abc](https://finance.rutgers.edu/student-abc) beginning in mid-July. Payment due dates begin in August. See payment plan options at [go.rutgers.edu/paymentplan](https://go.rutgers.edu/paymentplan).

## August
