FIRST STEP: Activate your NetID and enroll in two-step login

Activate your NetID 1–2 days after your offer of admission at netid.rutgers.edu to gain access to the myRutgers Portal (my.rutgers.edu), where you can view important information about next steps. Then enroll in two-step login with Duo to access most Rutgers services and tools requiring a NetID login. Learn more at twostep.rutgers.edu.

October

□ Choose a tuition payment plan (optional)

- Rutgers offers several tuition payment plans that allow you to pay your term bill charges over time in convenient monthly installments. For more information, visit go.rutgers.edu/paymentplan.

□ Complete placement tests *(within 30 days of enrollment)* first-year students only

- Placement testing for math, English, and most world languages is conducted online. Upon activating your NetID, your tests can be accessed at my.rutgers.edu under “My Enrollment: Required.” Testing must be completed by 3 p.m. on January 12.

November

□ Register for International Student Orientation *through January*

- Register for orientation at my.rutgers.edu. Visit global.rutgers.edu/ISO to learn more.

□ Receive your credit evaluation *through January* transfer students only

- All incoming transfer students will receive a credit evaluation by the appropriate academic dean's office once their official transcript is received. If you are a New Jersey community college student, visit njtransfer.org to view the transferability of courses.

□ Submit the required documents for your I-20 *through January*

- To receive your I-20, you must first accept our offer of admission and submit the necessary financial documents. Please monitor your email after accepting your admission for detailed instructions on how to request your Rutgers Form I-20 through the RGlobal Portal.

December

□ Submit your immunization record *by December 1*

- All immunization documentation must be uploaded directly to your Student Immunization Portal by December 1. If you accept our offer of admission after this date, you must submit your records within seven calendar days of accepting our offer. Learn more at rutgers.edu/student-immunizations.

December

❑ Sign up for on-campus housing *December–January 7*

- Access the forms at oncampus.rutgers.edu after you have enrolled and activated your NetID.

❑ Accept offer of admission *by December 7*

- After December 7, we cannot guarantee that your space will remain available. If you are admitted to Rutgers after December 1, you will have one week to accept our offer of admission.

❑ View your term bill *mid-December*

- Term bills are available online at finance.rutgers.edu/student-abc beginning in mid- to late-December. Payment due dates begin the first week of January.

❑ Complete academic planning and advising *through January* first-year students only

- Learn about degree requirements and plan your spring course schedule. You are more likely to graduate on time by registering for at least 15 credits per semester. Find more information at my.rutgers.edu.

❑ Attend Students in Transition Advising and Registration (STAR) program *through January* transfer students only

- Meet with academic advisers to learn about degree requirements and register for spring courses. Attend a virtual or in-person event based on your school of enrollment. Find more information at my.rutgers.edu.

❑ Obtain your I-20, pay your SEVIS I-901 fee, and apply for a visa *through January*

- After receiving your I-20 from Rutgers, pay your SEVIS I-901 fee at fmjfee.com and apply for your visa at a U.S. embassy or consulate. Visit ice.gov/sevis/i901/faq for more information.

January

❑ Submit your final official transcript *by January 7*

- Your final records must include certification of any diplomas or degrees, as well as final grades for courses in progress at the time of your admission. Transcripts can be sent electronically via Naviance/Parchment or SCOIR, emailed to transcripts@admissions.rutgers.edu, or mailed to: University Enrollment Services Admissions Processing, Proctor Hall, 65 Davidson Road, Suite 308, Piscataway, NJ 08854. Please know that it may take up to 10 business days for transcripts sent to Rutgers to reflect as received on your Application Portal.

❑ Pay your term bill *early January*

- Pay your term bill at finance.rutgers.edu/student-abc. The due date will be displayed on your term bill.

❑ Prepare for arrival in the U.S.

- For information to assist you in preparing for your arrival, visit ice.gov/sevis/students. F-1 visa holders currently in the U.S. should work with their school adviser to have their SEVIS record transferred to Rutgers.

❑ Attend International Student Orientation *January 19*

- Meet other new students, become familiar with the campus, and engage with campus resources to have your questions answered before classes begin.

❑ Attend Spring Welcome Week *begins January 20*

- Attend campus programs and events designed to help you find connections and community, navigate campus, and participate in campus traditions to prepare for the upcoming semester. Learn more at welcome.rutgers.edu.

❑ Spring semester begins *January 20*
