

# YOU'RE IN! NOW LET'S PLAN FOR THE MONTHS AHEAD.

## **FIRST STEP:** Activate your NetID and enroll in two-step login

Activate your NetID 1–2 days after your offer of admission at [netid.rutgers.edu](https://netid.rutgers.edu) to gain access to the myRutgers portal ([my.rutgers.edu](https://my.rutgers.edu)), where you can view important information about next steps. Then enroll in two-step login with Duo to access most Rutgers services and tools requiring a NetID login. Learn more at [twostep.rutgers.edu](https://twostep.rutgers.edu).

### **Financial Aid Reminder**

The Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) priority filing date was January 15, but we encourage you to apply as soon as possible if you haven't already. Submit your FAFSA at [studentaid.gov](https://studentaid.gov) or New Jersey Alternative Financial Aid Application (NJAFSA) at [hesaa.org](https://hesaa.org).

## March

### □ **Honors notification** *March*

All students who opted in for honors consideration on their admissions application will be notified by email about their decision for the Honors College.

### □ **Complete placement tests** *starting March 2 (within 30 days of enrollment)*

Placement testing for math, English, and most world languages is conducted online. Upon activating your NetID, your tests can be accessed at [my.rutgers.edu](https://my.rutgers.edu) under “Required for Enrollment.” If you enroll prior to March 1, you should complete all tests by March 30; otherwise, please complete tests within 30 days of enrolling. Students awaiting accommodations are not subject to these timelines.

### □ **Financial aid and scholarship notification** *starting early March*

Financial aid awards and scholarships will be available in the Financial Aid Student Portal located on [my.rutgers.edu](https://my.rutgers.edu) by early March for all admitted students who submitted a FAFSA or NJAFSA by January 15. Please note that this timeline may change.

### □ **Complete your housing application** *March–June 5*

- Access the application at [my.rutgers.edu](https://my.rutgers.edu) after you have enrolled and activated your NetID.
- Interested in living with a smaller group of students that share a common interest? Consider an academic, special interest, or themed living-learning community. ### □ **Choose a tuition payment plan (optional)** *March–mid-July*

## April

### □ **Attend Admitted Student Open House** *April 11*

Save the date for Admitted Student Open House on Saturday, April 11. Check your email for Open House details and registration information.

## May

### ❑ **Accept our offer of admission** *by May 1*

Accept our offer of admission at [admissions.rutgers.edu/accept](https://admissions.rutgers.edu/accept). After May 1, we cannot guarantee your space will remain available.

## June

### ❑ **Submit your immunization record** *by June 1*

All incoming students are required to comply with NJ State and University immunization requirements. The requirements and reporting processes are found on the Rutgers Immunization website at [rutgers.edu/student-immunizations](https://rutgers.edu/student-immunizations).

### ❑ **Sign up for New Student Orientation** *by June 5*

Meet other new students, become familiar with campus, and have your questions answered. Visit [transition.rutgers.edu](https://transition.rutgers.edu) to learn more.

### ❑ **Submit your housing application** *by June 5*

### ❑ **Make your housing selection** *mid-June*

- You will be notified when to make your selection. At your scheduled time, you will choose your residence hall and room based on availability.
- Create a back-up plan should your preference become unavailable at the time of selection.
- Students participating in honors housing or a living-learning community will not be required to participate in the housing selection process, as housing will be assigned.

### ❑ **Complete academic planning and advising** *June–August*

Learn about degree requirements and plan your fall course schedule. You are more likely to graduate on time by registering for at least 15 credits per semester. Find more information at [my.rutgers.edu](https://my.rutgers.edu).

## July

### ❑ **Submit your final official transcript(s)** *by July 1*

Your final records must include certification of any diplomas or degrees, as well as final grades for courses in progress at the time of your admission. Transcripts can be sent electronically via Naviance/Parchment or SCOIR or mailed to: University Enrollment Services Admissions Processing, Proctor Hall, 65 Davidson Road, Suite 308, Piscataway, NJ 08854. Please note that it takes an average of two weeks for your Application Portal to confirm receipt of your final official transcript.

### ❑ **View your term bill** *mid-July*

Term bills are available at [finance.rutgers.edu/student-abc](https://finance.rutgers.edu/student-abc) beginning in mid-July. Payment due dates begin in August. See payment plan options at [go.rutgers.edu/paymentplan](https://go.rutgers.edu/paymentplan).
